## President's report

- The main purpose of the meeting was to finalize the details of the BCI / OCW Bike Rally on Sat.
- Approx. 150 people are expected 81 BCI and 54 OCW signed up at present
- Tommie bringing a box for money, 2 coolers, 4 card tables, 50 water bottles (what would we do without Tommie)
- Jim made extra ride slips
- Monica is bringing 2 coolers, in charge of the general set up at 8:00am, subway sandwich delivery, in charge of greeting and ride start, (Monica walks on water too)
- Steve and Bruce are getting 100 more water bottles and ice
- Mike is bringing coffee for pre-ride and post ride and staying at the park to greet any vendors who arrive and watch supplies
- The Bicycle Garage folks may provide sag the riders and sweep
- All other board members available will arrive at 8:00am to help set up and clean up after the lunch
- Laurie called Voler Sportswear, questioning the issue of purchasing a single jersey at a time. She was told a 15 piece minimum was required.
- Tommie suggested we put an email alert and ask if anyone is interested in ordering a jersey, or other clothing. We could put together a large order periodically to avoid holding stock on hand.

#### Treasurer's report

• Linda presented a financial comparison report 6 mo. of 2010 compared to 1<sup>st</sup> 6 mo. Of 2011. Membership due were down. Not mailing out the newsletter made up the loss. Insurance costs up slightly. See report for details.

## Ride Coordinator's report-

• We begin 8:00 am ride start on Sunday for July and August. Ann agreed to have an 8:00 am ride start on Sat. also (if we get any participation). Need to post on web site.

- A Club ride with the Covina Cycling club was discussed. A ride with them is proposed Aug 6<sup>th</sup>. The elevation gain for the 56 mile route is 1786 ft.
- Safety was discussed. We need to emphasize stopping and stop signs and red lights at the beginning of rides. Riding in single file is best—mainly for other riders who want to pass and not be forced into a driving lane.
- Methods of a safer ride start need to be considered. Bill suggested leaving the
  parking lot in double file—using cones to guide us. Perhaps letting the faster
  riders leave first within each color group—making smaller groups—and spacing
  them out farther.
- A lady from the community who had a child going into the park building on a Sat. was very upset because so many cyclist were in the way. We need to be sure to keep a clear avenue open from the street to the door and be aware of children in the area. Remind cycling friends around who are not attentive.

### Communications report-

Rhonda implemented a new feature on the webpage --- Ride reports. Anyone
can submit a report of a remote ride—or any ride. The list goes back for years,
which gives us ideas for future years. (Good thing Rhonda retired, now all that
great brain power can focus on BCI)
